GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. UG, PG and PhD/Research Scholars are eligible to present their work in the areas mentioned in the brochure.
2. Full paper in A4 size maximum up to 6 pages should be submitted.
3. All presentations are to be in English. The presenter should be able to understand and respond to audience questions in English.
4. The soft copy of the paper is to be submitted in PDF and word format (MS Office 2003, 2007 format) as per the IEEE conference format attached herewith. The format may also be accessed from the following link :

5. The paper must include an abstract of about 150 words with maximum of five keywords. It should be specified just after the abstract content.
6. Final list of Participants and Seminar schedule of paper presentation will be available on www.sal.edu.in
7. Information about necessary revisions will be communicated to the corresponding author through e-mail. The full length of the paper will be reviewed by the Technical committee. If the paper is expected, the author(s) should incorporate the suggestions given by reviewers.
8. Authors presenting more than one paper have to register separately for each paper.
9. Maximum five authors including guide name is permissible.
10. Presentations are to be of 10 minutes, inclusive of 2 minutes for questions.
11. Presenters should save their presentation in both .pdf and .ppt format on a flash drive (Pen drive). ***Cloud-based storage (e.g. Dropbox, Google Drive) and presentation software (e.g. Prezi) should not be used, as access to the internet is not available.***
12. Presenters are informed to upload their presentations to the provided system between 9 to 9.30 am on both the days.
13. Executive / professional Dress code is recommended.
